### Footy Exhibition Update

### Presentations of Work

**Justin** – showed us his folio as well as several images he's had published in various cycling magazines both in Australia and England. It was interesting to hear how he went about approaching magazines to sell his images and it was inspiring to see how he had made money from his passion for cycling and his passion for photography.

**Georgia** – showed us images from her photographic installation piece that was on display for one day at festa della republica held at the Exhibition Building recently. There was about 40 B&W images Georgia has taken over the last few years based on the various Ethnic Communities in and around Melbourne. There was a combination of 6x6 images and 35mm. The images were a great testament to Georgia's ability to relate to people and make them oblivious to the camera.

**John** – showed us images from his recent trip to Italy. These images were taken using his Kodak DSC 14N with a giant 14 megapixels! Most of the images were large digital prints which had a wonderful hand-painted quality to them. The scenes were striking images of an Italian fishing village and a village in the hill country. Excellent work especially given that he only got the camera 2 days before his trip!
